


# BUSY BEE QUILTERS NAME BADGE





## CONSTRUCTION (allow 1/4" seam allowance on pattern)

1. Cut a cardboard circle the size of the #1 piece.
2. Draw, on any color flannel, one circle the size of the #1 piece and one circle 1/8" larger than the #1 piece (to allow for padding).
3. Embroider in black "BUSY BEE QUILTERS" and the bee. In a color to coordinate with the calico petals, embroider your name.
4. Cut out 12 petals from any calico fabric(s) and sew together making 6 separate petals (#2 piece).
5. Wrap smaller flannel circle around cardboard circle and glue edges.
6. Two methods can be used to finish:
  - ♦ Glue petals around edges of cardboard, then place small amount of batting on top of cardboard. Next, fold under edges of larger circle and glue so that the petals are "sandwiched" between top and bottom.
  - ♦ Sew petals to right side of embroidered piece, place a small amount of batting on cardboard, and then glue to flannel-wrapped cardboard. Remember to tuck under seam before gluing.
7. Position large safety pin on the back and hold in place by gluing a small piece of fabric over closed side on pin.


Some Busy Bee's have used needlepoint plastic instead of cardboard and then fabric of their choice.



## Washable Sewn Method



Right sides together  
sew a front & back together.  
Trim seam to 1/8 in. Turn.



Clip to scant 1/4 in.



Attach pin or neck ribbon. Wear proudly.
